than you even know.

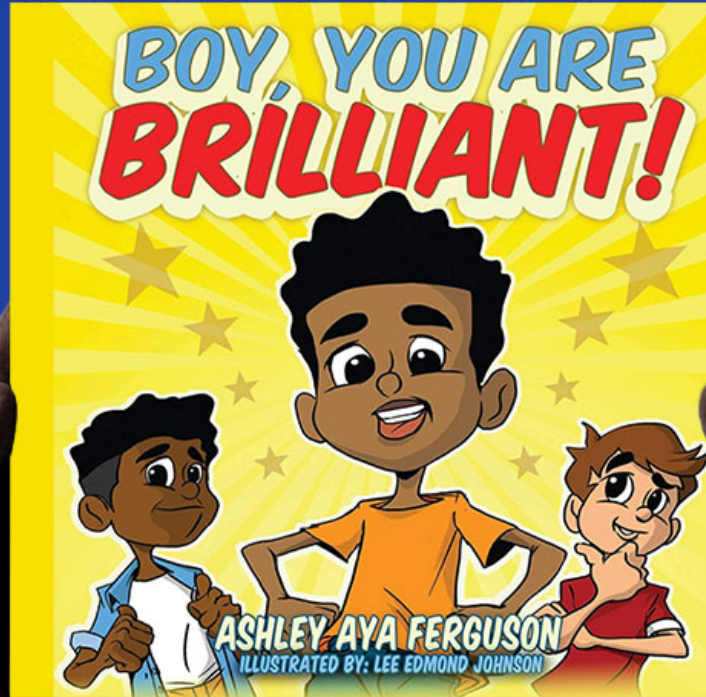
